This work will enhance pedestrian safety, particularly around schools where the highest concentration of vulnerable road users is usually found. The statutory public comment process is an important aspect of this undertaking. Although it is the City's intention to implement traffic calming measures at all the sites listed via the link below, it will be subject to the availability of funding.
