

WINTER READINESS ASSISTANCE TO ORGANISATIONS

The City of Cape Town recognises the plight of people living on the street. In its efforts to reduce the number of people living on the street, it supports non-profit organisations (NPOs) and public benefit organisations (PBOs) by supplementing their existing resources.

Through its Winter Readiness Programme, the City supports organisations to increase their bed capacity, particularly during the harsh winter months. The programme will be implemented from 29 April 2024 to 31 October 2024 through the provision of mattresses, cleaning materials, blankets, bedding, hygiene packs and dry food ingredients. Our partner organisations will not be expected to create any permanent accommodation.

Criteria

The participating organisation must:

- Be registered as an NPO or PBO
- Have existing facilities to accommodate clients and address their needs through developmental programmes
- Be compliant with requirements of Population Certificate
- Comply with all health and safety regulations
- Agree to site inspections that the City's Fire and Safety Departments, Environmental Health Departments and Social Development and ECD Department that will conduct before approval is granted
- Have an approved building plan
- Submit a draft lay-out/floor plan for the additional bed spaces applied for
- Have a Certificate of Acceptability for Food Premises
