



HAVE YOUR SAY! DRAFT STRATEGY TO REDUCE ROUGH SLEEPING

The City of Cape Town calls for public comment on the Draft Strategy to Reduce Rough Sleeping.

The draft strategy aims to set out:

- a definition for homelessness and for rough sleeping to ensure that the City's administration and other strategic instruments which address homelessness are uniformly applied
- the City's processes to identify rough sleepers in order to deliver the services and projects approved in its Integrated Development Plan (IDP) and with the allocated budget
- the means by which the City will support the referral and reintegration of rough sleepers into families, the community and society
- the roles and responsibilities of the various roleplayers in the City of Cape Town
- the City's responsibility in the provision of infrastructure for safe spaces, as well as a commitment towards the Safe Spaces Project
- a commitment to an interface model to support collaboration between all relevant roleplayers in the sector

Members of the public in the City of Cape Town are invited to submit comments to the municipality from 22 April 2024 to 22 May 2024 quoting "rough sleeping" as a reference, in respect of the Draft Strategy to Reduce Rough Sleeping.
